

Little Monster® Walking Finger Puppets

1. Color each of the puppets.

2. Cut out each puppet along its solid outline. To cut out the finger holes, first punch a hole in each with a pencil point. Start cutting in the pencil hole and carefully cut around the dotted line.

3. Put your index and middle fingers through the finger holes from the back. Make the puppet walk by moving your fingers. Have a puppet on each hand. Make a story for them to act out.

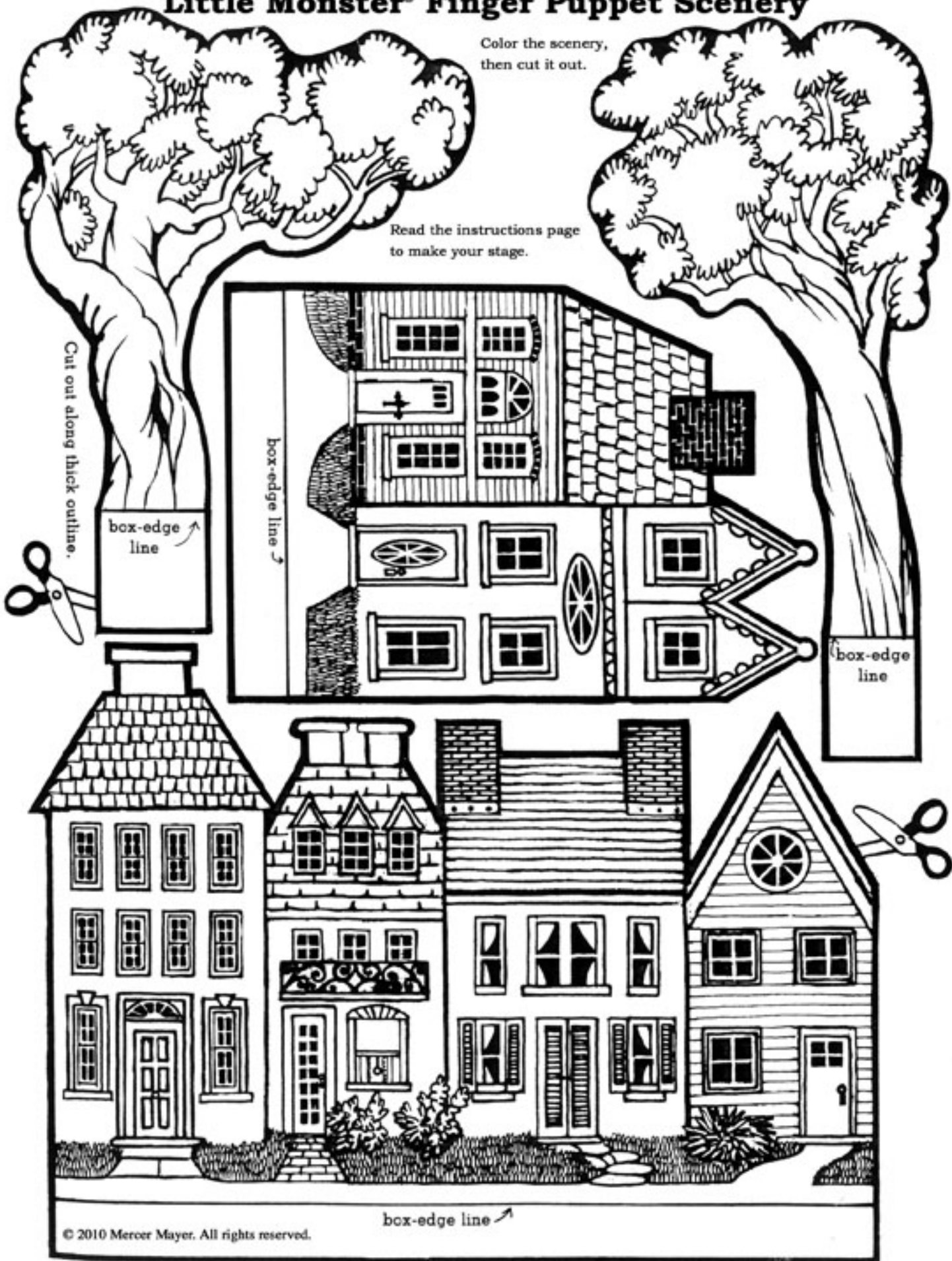

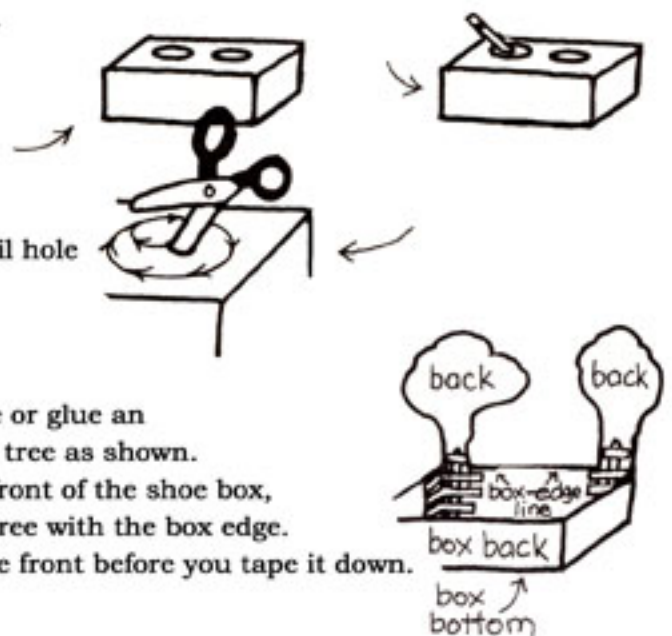


Make a Little Monster® Finger Puppet Stage

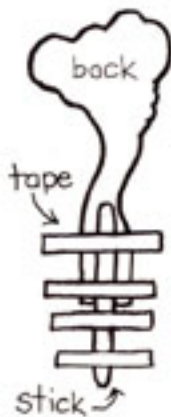
INSTRUCTIONS: Use a shoe box to make your stage.

You will not need the box lid.

1. Turn the box bottom up, and draw two circles big enough to fit your hands through.
2. Use a pencil to punch a hole through each circle.
3. Push the point of your scissors through each pencil hole and cut out the circles you drew.



4. Cut out the trees you colored. Tape or glue an ice-cream stick to the back of each tree as shown.
5. Tape the trees to the inside of the front of the shoe box, lining up the box edge line on the tree with the box edge. Be sure to see how it looks from the front before you tape it down.



6. Cut out the building scenery around the thick outline.
7. Tape together two pieces of building scenery to make a row of buildings. Match the box edge line to the edge of the box. Tape or glue the buildings to the inside of the back of the stage.



7. to make the buildings stand up better, tape or glue ice cream sticks to the back, as shown.

Here's how to hold the stage and puppets.

8. Paint or color the front and sides of your stage, or cover them with colored paper.

9. Your stage will look like this from the front.
